What We're Learning Next

Reading: Students will learn about the various literary devices used in poetry and the various kinds of poems. Later in the quarter, students will begin writing original Cinquain, Hiaku, List poems, etc. AKS describe how words and phrases (e.g., regular beats, alliteration, rhymes, repeated lines) supply rhythm and meaning in a story, poem, or song (CCOPS) (2LA_A2012-4/F.I.ACC2RI.4)

<u>Writing:</u> Our focus will be on writing friendly letters to favorite Disney characters. Students will work through the writing process to create letters. Students will also identify characteristics of a friendly letter in the process. AKS: participate in shared research and writing projects (CCOPS) (2LA_D2012-27/ELACC2W7)

<u>Math:</u> Our unit of study will focus on geometry. Students will recognize and demonstrate their understanding of shapes having specified attributes, such as angles, faces, etc. AKS: recognize and draw shapes having specified attributes, such as a given number of angles or a given number of equal faces and identify triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, and cubes (CCGPS) (2MA D2012-29/MCC2.6.1)

<u>Science:</u> Students will identify sources of light, heat, and motion energy. They will also demonstrate an understanding of how things move. AKS: identify sources of energy and how energy is used (GPS) (2SC_C2007-11). AKS: demonstrate changes in speed and direction using pushes and pulls (GPS) (2SC_C2007-12)

 $\underline{\textit{Word Work}}$ We will begin learning about Latin and Greek roots. We will focus on the base $\underline{\textit{port}}$ and the prefix $\underline{\textit{re}}$. Students will be assessed on Latin and Greek roots mid and end of quarter.

-port: transport, import, export, report, carport, airport -re: recycle, relearn, retell, rewrite, reheat, recopy March 14, 2014
