What We're Learning Next

Reading: Students will learn summarizing strategies for fiction and nonfiction (informational) texts. Students will learn to summarize using this acronym: Somebody, Wanted, But, Then, SO. This works best for fictional texts and highlights the main story elements. AKS: recount stories, including fables and folktales from diverse cultures, and determine their central message, lesson, or moral (CCGPS) (2LA_A2012-2/ELACC2RL2)

<u>Math:</u> We will review telling time to the nearest five minutes and explore problem solving. Students are practicing telling time using these vocabulary words: half past, quarter after, quarter past, quarter till. Please practice using these words when telling time. Time Assessment on Friday, March 14th. AKS: use analog and digital clocks to tell and write time to the nearest five minutes using AM and PM (CCGPS) (2MA_C2012-24/MCC2.MD.7)

<u>Science:</u> We will continue our unit on Space. We will also focus on the moon phases. Please assist in donating a pack of Double Stuffed Oreo cookies by Tuesday, March $11^{\rm th}$. We will be using these to explore the phases of the moon.

AKS: describe the universe as including the moon, sun, other stars, and planets (GPS) ($2SC_B2007-7$); investigate the position of the sun and moon to show patterns throughout the year (GPS) ($2SC_B2007-8$)

Social Studies: We have completed our learning on Jimmy Carter, Martin Luther King Jr., and Jackie Robinson. We will be learning about Georgia symbols and economics following our sience unit on space. AKS: read about and describe the lives of historical figures Martin Luther King Jr. and Jackie Robinson (GPS) (2SS_F2008-28); read about and describe the life of Jimmy Carter (GPS) (2SS_G2008-32).

<u>Word Work:</u> We will continue to explore the - oot and - ought word patterns this week. We will focus on vocabulary. The assessment will be Friday, March 14^{th} .

-oot: cahoots, snooty, hoot, loot

-ought: forethought, ought, sought, afterthought
